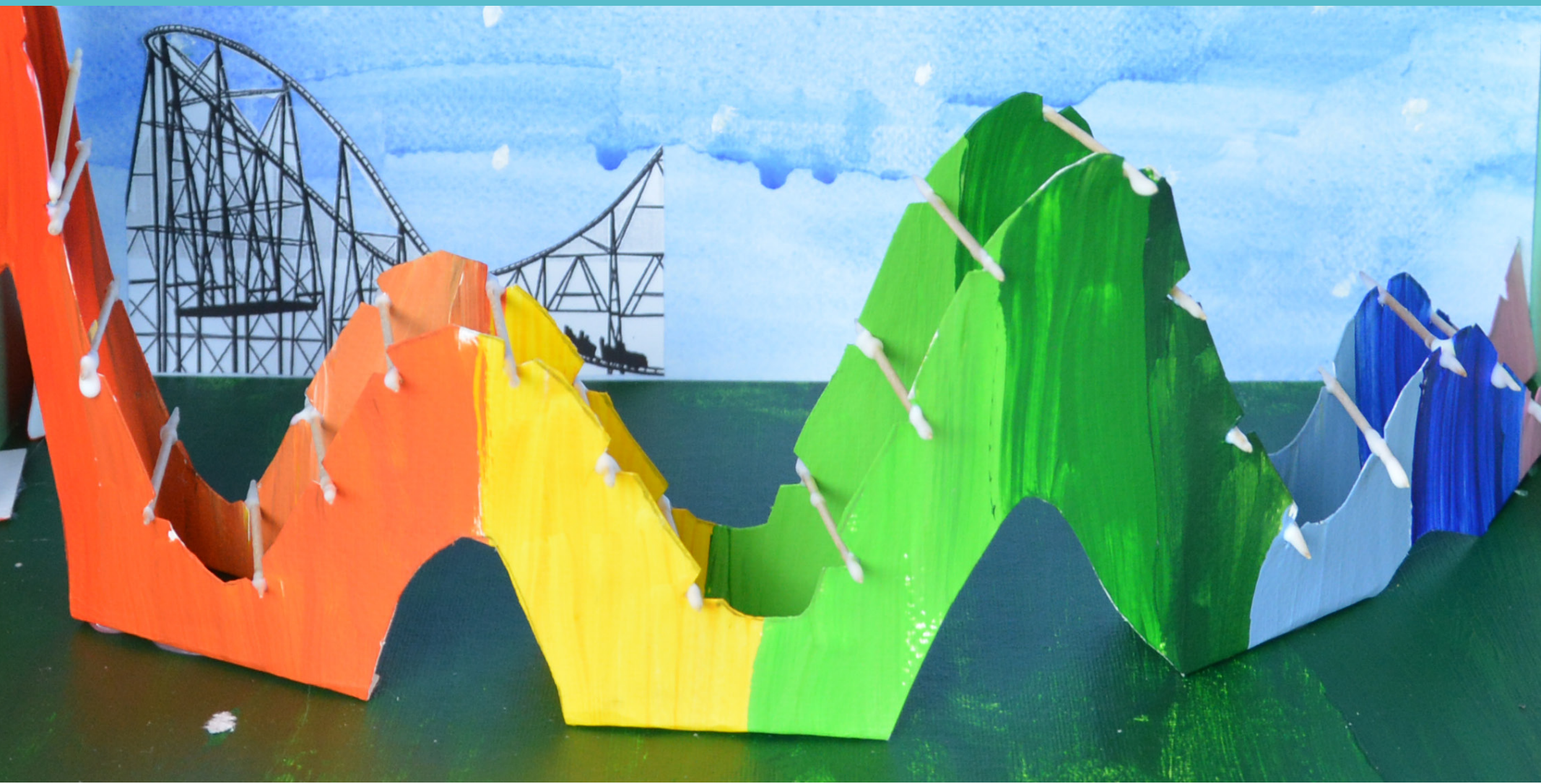


Summer 2018 FINE ARTS DAY CAMP & workshops



DAY CAMP - AGES 6-12*

Monday to Friday 9 am to 4:15 pm
Extended hours: 8 to 9 am and until 6 pm

Join us this summer for another creative and inspiring artistic journey! Delve into a wide range of art materials; learn new skills and experiment with different creative approaches. Each week we will explore new themes.

Our programme is taught by qualified and experienced teachers. Our small, bilingual classes of 15 students, grouped according to age, ensure that each child receives individual attention and is encouraged to advance at their own pace.

Activities take place in our fully equipped and air conditioned studios as well as at Westmount Park, where outdoor games and a weekly swim complement the afternoon programme.

Registration starts February 15

You may register your child on a weekly basis. New projects are introduced each week.

*Registered children must be at least 6 years old the date they attend camp. The day camp schedule and projects are not suitable for younger children.



Daily activities

9 am to 12 noon

Sculpture, drawing, painting, and ceramics are the focus of the morning art activities, giving children an opportunity to imaginatively and expressively explore these media while simultaneously developing skills.

1 to 4 pm

The afternoon session offers a fun and exciting workshop atmosphere in which to explore a specific art form that changes each week, such as collage, print-making, book arts, sculpture, and digital media. Experimentation, creativity, and self-expression are encouraged, as well as skill development and an understanding of basic artistic concepts. Part of the afternoon will include physical activities (i.e. games at the park; weekly yoga; and a weekly swim, weather permitting).

4:15 to 6 pm - Extended hours

You can also register your child for a late pick-up service until 6 pm. Activities include: creating bracelets, drawing, beading, and other quiet games.



This year's theme is:

MOVEMENT IN ART

Let's delve into what movement can mean in visual art. This summer, explore how artistic movements are initiated, actions artists can take to become catalysts of change, and how creative engagement can foster a sense of community. Movement will be examined in conceptual and physical ways. Campers will be immersed in these creative investigations and equipped with various media to express their thoughts and inspirations about society, environment, and community.

YOUTH WORKSHOPS

Weekly workshops starting Tuesday June 26* through Monday August 13. New projects every week.

Little Studio (ages 4-5)

Monday to Friday 9:30 am to 12 pm

Rich and varied materials such as clay, wood, fabric, paint, and papers provide opportunities for young children to create imaginative projects. This course is designed to stimulate and enhance a child's imagination and perception through participation in group activities and art making.

Adventure in Art (ages 6-8)

Monday to Friday 9:30 am to 12 pm

Students use exciting materials to create projects in both two and three dimensions. Children are encouraged to develop their own imagery and enter into the fascination of the visual world, both real and imaginary.

Drawing & Painting (ages 9-12)

Monday to Friday 1 to 4 pm

This course enables students to strengthen their drawing and painting techniques, to sharpen their observation skills, and to explore new media. Students may experiment with pencil, pen and ink, acrylic paint, watercolour, pastel, conté, and charcoal. Students are encouraged to develop their imagination, creativity, and their own style of expression.

Pottery & Sculpture (ages 13-17)

Monday to Friday 10:30 am to 12:30 pm

Two-week courses starting:
June 26*; July 9; July 23 and Aug. 6

Unearth the fascination of clay! Learn handbuilding, sculpture and pottery on the wheel, as well as various glazing techniques. Turn your ideas into reality.

Painting & Drawing Studio (ages 13-17)

Monday to Friday 1 to 4 pm

One-week workshops starting Tuesday June 26 through Monday August 13

Discover the creative potential of various drawing and painting materials, which may include pencil, charcoal, conté, acrylic, and ink. Develop skills and creativity while learning new drawing and painting techniques. Work from sketches, observation, printed images, and imagination to create realistic, abstract, and expressive drawings and paintings.

\$170 (\$135 + \$35 materials) / week
